





Toi Gold Mine



The period from about 1370 to 1965 was Izu's golden era, supported by this gold mine, Izu's largest. The mine gained an entry in the Guinness Book of World Records and the world's largest gold nugget, weighing 250kg, is on display.

Izu-Kōgen 伊豆高原

Mt. Omuro

Mt. Omuro is a cinder cone (extinct volcano) with an elevation of 580m and a crater 300m in diameter. A ride by chair lift to the summit rewards you with an unforgettable 360-degree panoramic view that takes in the Amagi Range, Mt. Fuji, Mt. Hakone and other peaks.

- Chair-lift fare : Adult return (junior-high-school children and older) ¥700
Child return (Age 4 or under) ¥350




Izu Granpal Amusement Park (GRANILLUMI)

GRANILLUMI is so densely festooned with illuminations that when it is lit up at night it looks like nothing else on earth. Visitors to Izu Granpal Amusement Park are quickly swept up into another world.



Atagawa Tropical & Alligator Garden

This zoo uses geothermal hot-spring water to raise and grow alligators and tropical plants. Don't miss the cute lesser pandas and Amazon manatees.

Atagawa is sacred ground. Years ago Benzaiten, the Buddhist goddess of music, appeared in a dream to an ancestor of the land owner and told him that if he dug here he would find an abundance of hot springs. The goddess was true to her words. The ancestor dug and found hot spring water which was at 100 degrees. It is said that if you pour hot water over her she will grant you a wish.

Inatori Hosono Plateau

At the base of Mt. Misui in the Izuamagi Range, a 125ha grassland spreads out, overlooking the sea of Sagami and Izu Shichitou. It is thick with Japanese pampas grass in the fall and ripe for picking mountain vegetables in the spring, making this plateau an ideal hiking area.
