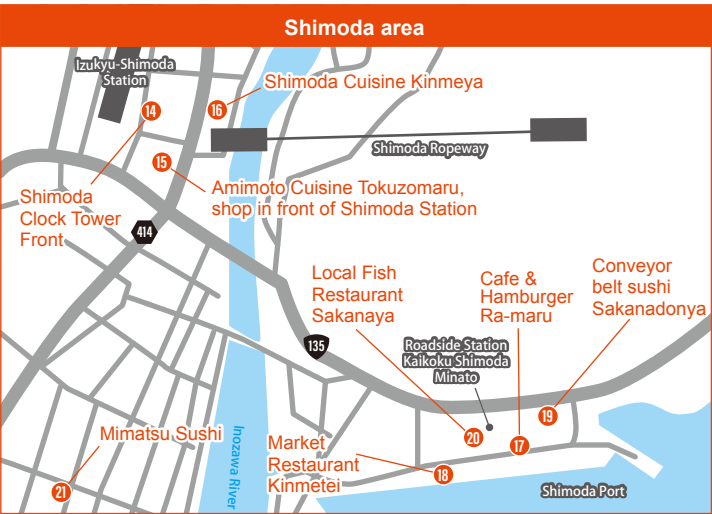
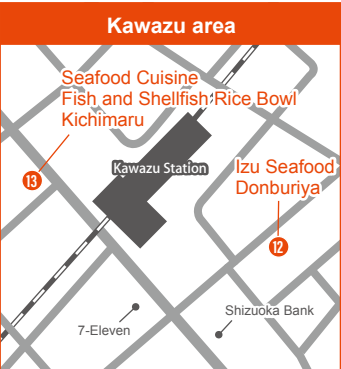
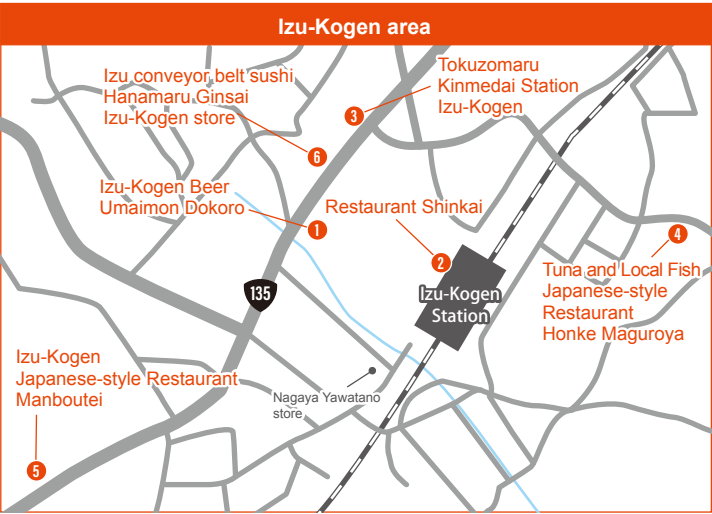




Points of caution when purchasing/using

1. Ensure that you check the **regular holidays and the operating hours** of the shops you are planning to visit before purchase.
2. Please be aware that Kinmedai may see a **temporary closure or a may not be able to offer Kinmedai dishes** based on their stocking situation.
*Kinmedai is a rare deep-sea fish that can be difficult to procure due to reasons such as weather.
3. The Kinmedai dishes offered **may not have been caught in Izu** depending on the shop.
4. Receipts for the Kinme Ticket can only be issued at the place of purchase.
*Please be aware that receipts are not issued at each single shop.
5. The effective period for transportation tickets is **limited to the date of use**, and the effective period for meal tickets is **within seven days (one week) of the date of use**. Meal tickets are effective for single use within seven days (one week) of the date of use.
*Please be aware that there are **no refunds** for transportation or meal tickets **after purchase**.
6. When using a meal ticket, **please pass it to staff immediately after entering a shop (before ordering)**.
7. During busy seasons like long holidays, it may be **difficult to enter shops due to an excessive number of visitors or we may not be able to offer you Kinmedai dishes due to selling out**.
8. Kinmedai dishes offered via the meal ticket differ depending on the shop, **so they cannot be exchanged for other dishes**.
9. A portion of shops have their **closest stations outside of the Unlimited Ride Ticket area**. If taking a train to the nearest station, please pay the separate fare for that section.

Hand the "Meal Ticker" on the right to shop staff. Customers can pick one course per person from the shops listed in this leaflet.

*Operating hours and regular holidays are subject to change without prior notice. Please check with each shop before visiting and using.

[Transportation Ticket Validity]	Unlimited riding of local trains (including rapid trains) between Izu-Kogen Station and Izukyu-Shimoda Station for a single day Riding the limited express requires a limited express ticket that is sold separately.

The Kinmedai catch at Izu's Shimoda Port is the best in Japan!

Kinmedai, fatty with plenty of white meat, has a luxurious bite. Recently, it has become a very popular deep sea fish as a high-quality fish. Izu's Shimoda Port catches the most Kinmedai in all of Japan.

Inatori Kinme is a brand of Kinmedai caught in Izu's Inatori Port

Inatori Kinme, outstandingly fatty with plenty of meat, is traded for a higher price than other Kinmedai. This is because it undergoes strict quality management before being shipped to market.
