Usage Conditions

The Izukyū Rail Pass **1-Day**, **2-Day** and **3-Day** are unlimited ride tickets for the Izukyū Railway (between Itō Station and Izukyū-Shimoda Station) for foreigners visiting Japan.

- Effective period:** Izukyū Rail Pass 1-Day 1 day
Izukyū Rail Pass 2-Day 2 days in a row
Izukyū Rail Pass 3-Day 3 days in a row
- Validity:** Can use unreserved seats on Izukyū Railway local and rapid trains.
Riding the limited express requires a limited express ticket that is sold separately.
- How to purchase:** Show any passport issued outside of Japan
- Stations selling:** Ito Station (9:00 to 17:00)
Izu-Kōgen Station, Izukyū-Shimoda Station (6:00 to 19:00)
Izu-Atagawa Station, Izu-Inatori Station (8:10 to 17:30)
Kawazu Station (9:00 to 17:30)
- Purchase Online:** This can be purchased online and exchanged at stations other than Ito Station.

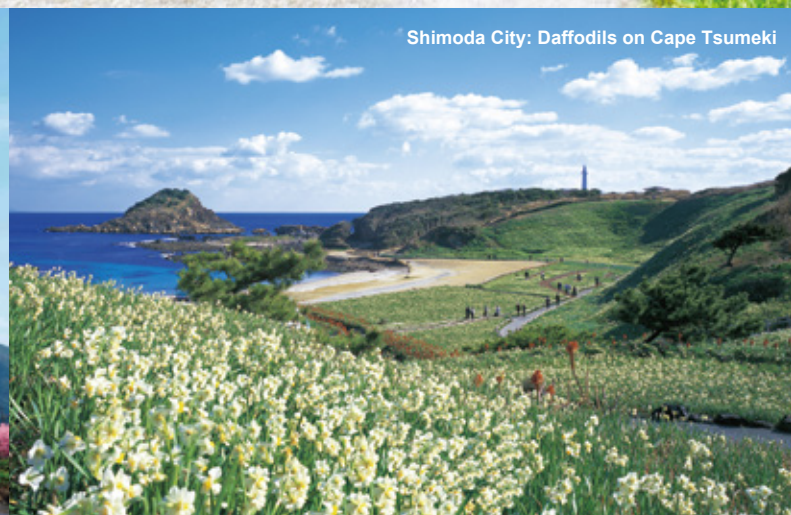

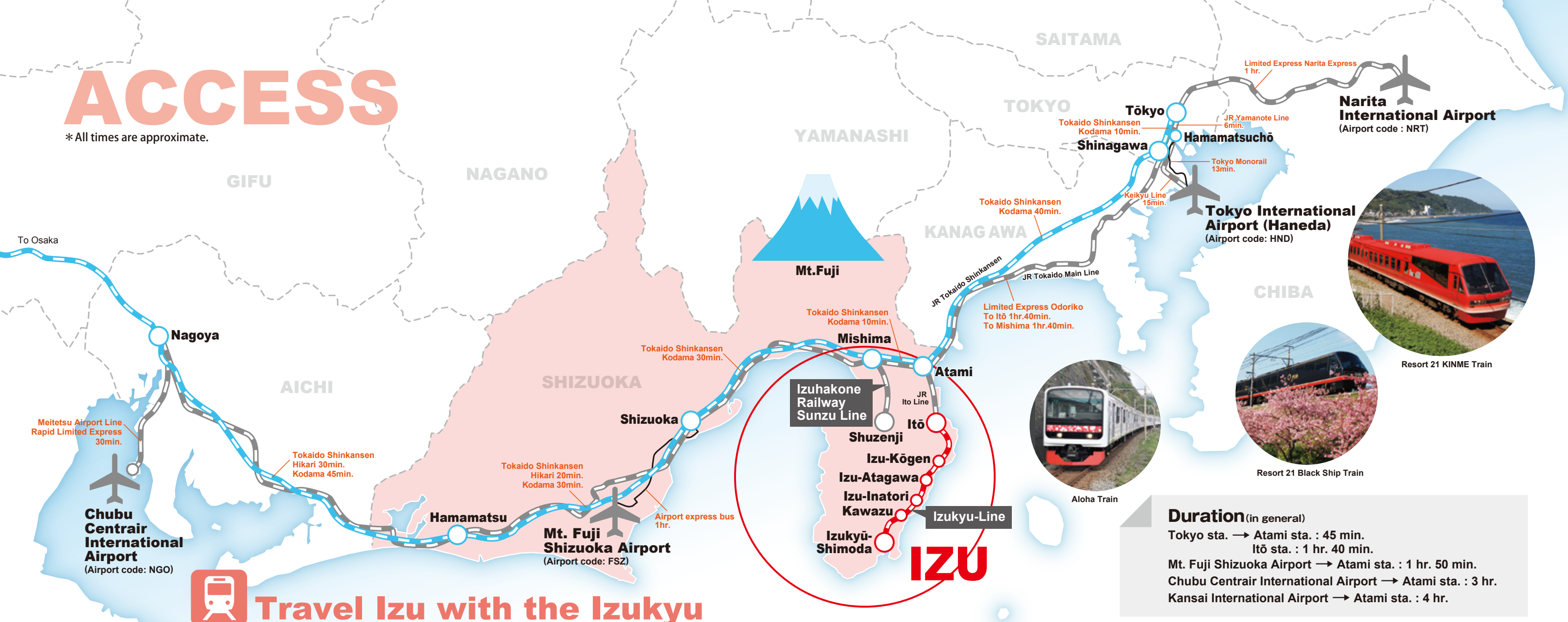

Day-of reservations: Ask directly at the counter

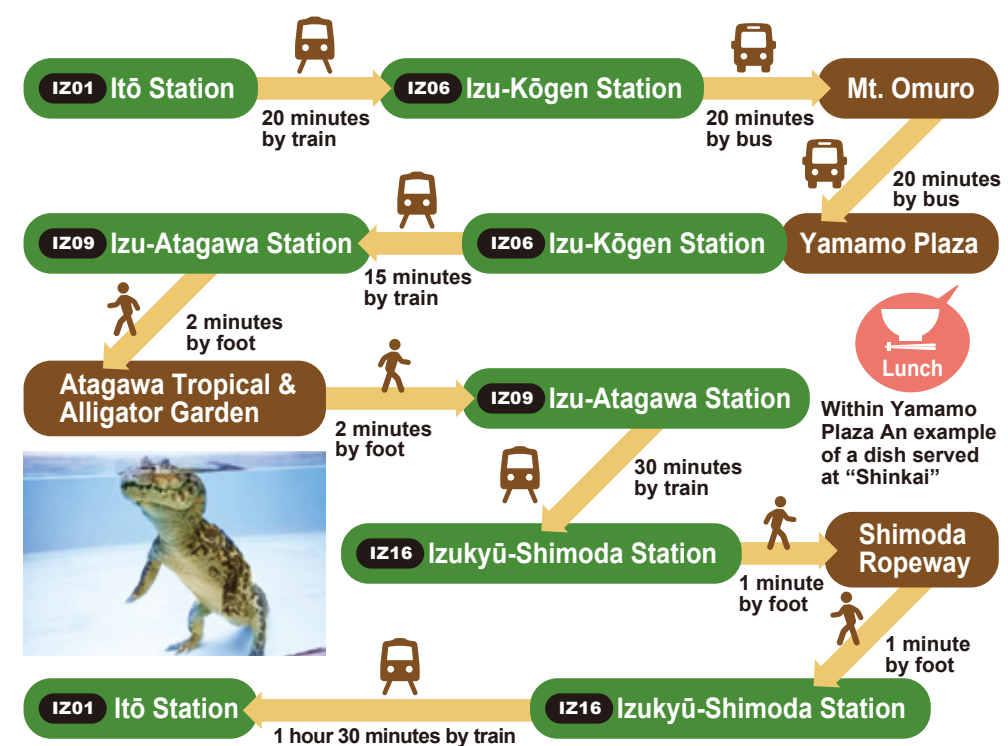

IZU MAP



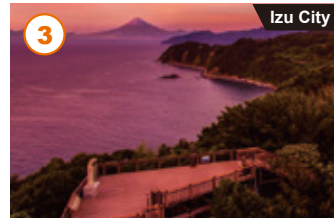
Recommended Sightseeing Spots



Izu Panorama Park (Mt. Katsuragi)
7 minutes by ropeway to the peak of Mt. Katsuragi. You can get a superb view of Mt. Fuji from the peak, which has an elevation of 452 meters.



Shuzen-ji Temple
Established by high priest Kukai, this ancient temple is where Shuzenji gets its name from. This picturesque spot also has a superb view of Okamoto's "The Tale of Shuzen-ji."



Koibito Misaki (Lover's Cape)
Ringing the bell at Koibito Misaki (Lover's Cape) three times is said to lead to fulfillment in love. This picturesque spot also has a superb view of Mt. Fuji.



Dogashima Marine
With a curtain of light shining through the cave's natural skylight, this trip by pleasure boat will move you with the mysteries of nature you'll discover in the clear blue sea of the "Blue Grotto."



Irozaki Lighthouse
You can see the horizon from the tip of the southernmost cape of the Izu Peninsula and check to see if the earth really is round. This medium-sized lighthouse, which stands as a tower of chalk, was selected as one of the fifty most notable lighthouses in Japan.



Komuroyama Ridge Walk "MISORA"
With a length of 166.3 meters, the looping rising and falling promenade makes the most of the scoria cone. The single-person lift lets you enjoy a 360° view of the magnificent natural scenery of the sea and sky from its 321 meter peak, such as Mt. Fuji, Sagami Sea, Boso Peninsula, Izu Islands and the Amagi Mountains.



Tokaikan
Established in 1928 as a hot spring ryokan, it's now a standing remnant of the architectural style of wooden buildings from the early Showa era as a sightseeing and cultural facility for Ito. Hot springs for day trips are also possible.



Jogasaki Coast Kadowaki Suspension Bridge
The scenery at the precipice created from lava that flowed from an eruption of Mt. Omuro is breathtaking. You can even make your way across a thrilling suspension bridge.



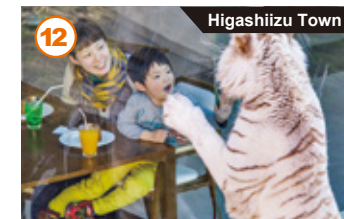
Oyukake Benzaiten
A holy spot where 100°C water gushed forth, as Benzaiten (Japanese Buddhist Goddess) spoke about while appearing in a dream. There's also a legend that you can increase your luck with money if you wash some in the Takara Pond.



Izu Shaboten Zoo
In winter, you can see the beloved Capybara soaking in the open-air bath. It's a cute, comforting site to behold.



Atagawa Tropical & Alligator Garden
A zoo where the heat from hot springs is used to breed and culture crocodiles and tropical plants. You've also got to see the cute red pandas and the Amazon manatees.



Izu Animal Kingdom
There are a lot of rare animals, like white tigers. This zoo lets you interact directly with many different animals.



Funado-no-Banya
You're able to enjoy a variety of nature experiences, such as an outdoor bath with a superb view, a barbecue of freshly caught seafood, a variety of set meals, salt making and mandarin orange jam making.



Kawazu Nanadaru Seven Waterfalls
The seven waterfalls in this spot provide a great deal of comfort. You can also enjoy a relaxing walk along the promenade. There's a bronze statue from renowned author Yasunari Kawabata's "The Dancing Girl of Izu," making this a famous spot for commemorative photos.



Shimoda Ropeway Observation Cafe & Restaurant THE ROYAL HOUSE
It's approximately 3 minutes by ropeway to the top of Mt. Nesugata, where you can have a bird's-eye view of Shimoda Port, the Izu Islands and the magnificent Amagi Mountains. The peak has a famous matchmaking spot, Aizendo Temple, and an observation cafe and restaurant where you can leisurely enjoy the food and superb view.



Shimoda Aquarium
An aquarium that makes the most of the natural beauty of Izu's ocean where you can play with dolphins. During the show, you may be able to have the special experience of having the dolphins jump directly over your head.



Yumigahama Beach
Yumigahama has a beautiful coastline that extends for over 1 km, along with broad stretches of white, sandy beaches. This beach in the southernmost part of Minamizu was selected as one of the 100 best shores in Japan.



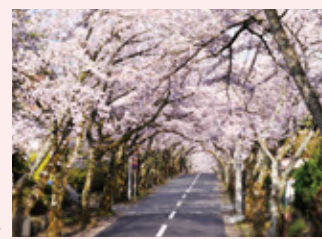
Ryugukutsu Cave
A portion of the ceiling of this large sea cave has given way, opening up a skylight that's around 50 meters in diameter. Looking up from below, you'll find yourself in a curious space where the ceiling suddenly opens up. There's a promenade above, and you can walk all the way around. If you look down, you'll be able to see a heart-shaped landform!

Izu Event Guide

A Atami Baiken Plum Garden Plum Festival
Including cherry blossom trees that are over 100 years old, you can enjoy the early, normal and late flowering of approximately 60 varieties of cherry blossoms during the festival period.
●Venue: Atami City
●Period: Early Jan - early Mar



B Izu Highland Row of cherry blossoms
The Izu Highland row of cherry blossoms is a renowned cherry blossom spot! The scenery in the cherry blossom tunnel that spans nearly 3 km from the station is superb.
●Venue: Ito City
●Period: Late Mar - early Apr



C Kawazu Cherry Blossom Festival
Kawazu cherry blossoms feature flowers that are large and pink. The Kawazu Cherry Blossom Festival is held every year from the start of February for approximately 1 month. It's bustling with people who have come to see the blossoms.
●Venue: Kawazu Town
●Period: February 1 - 28



D Shimoda Park Hydrangea Festival
Shimoda Park is located on a low mountain overlooking Shimoda Port, and the approximately 80 acre area is completely covered with over 3 million hydrangea sprouting from 150,000 trees.
●Venue: Shimoda City
●Period: June 1 - 30
