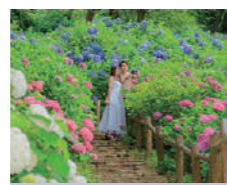

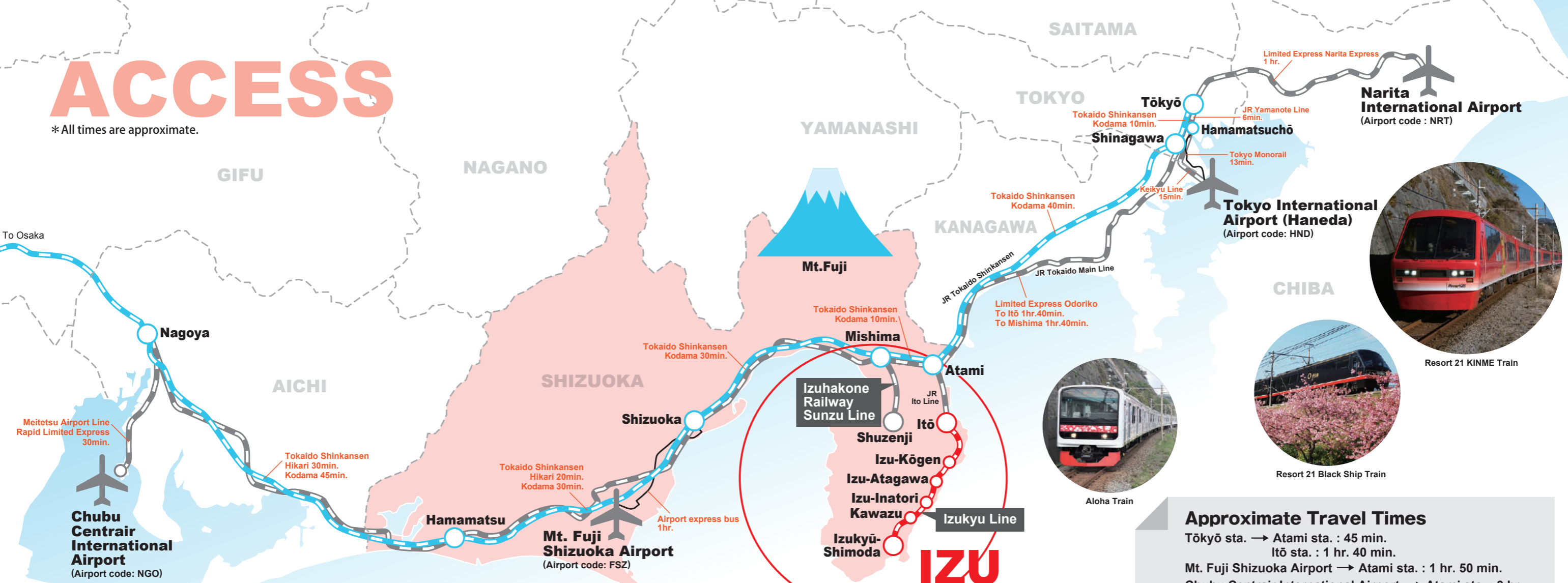

Recommended Sightseeing Spots



1 Tokaikan
Established in 1928 as a hot spring ryokan, it's now a standing remnant of the architectural style of wooden buildings from the early Showa era as a sightseeing and cultural facility for Ito. Hot springs for day trips are also possible.



2 Komuroyama Ridge Walk "MISORA"
With a length of 166.3 meters, the looping rising and falling promenade makes the most of the scoria cone. The single-person lift lets you enjoy a 360° view of the magnificent natural scenery of the sea and sky from its 321 meter peak, such as Mt. Fuji, Sagami Sea, Boso Peninsula, Izu Islands and the Amagi Mountains.



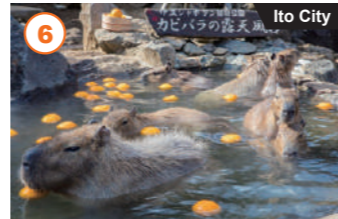
3 Jogasaki Coast Kadowaki Suspension Bridge
The scenery at the precipice created from lava that flowed from an eruption of Mt. Omuro is breathtaking. You can even make your way across a thrilling suspension bridge.



4 Izu Teddy Bear Museum
A charming museum where you can meet adorable teddy bears. There are also workshops where you can make your own stuffed toy.



5 Mt. Omuro
Mt. Omuro is a scoria cone (dormant volcano) with an elevation of 580 meters and a crater measuring 300 meters in diameter. Ride the ropeway to the summit and enjoy an unforgettable 360-degree panoramic view.



6 Izu Shaboten Zoo
In winter, you can see the beloved Capybara soaking in the open-air bath. It's a cute, comforting site to behold.



7 Kurone Rock Open-Air Bath
An open-air bath so close to the sea that you can feel the spray of the waves. A vast, open ocean view spreads out before you.



8 Oyukake Benzaiten
A holy spot where 100°C water gushed forth, as Benzaiten (Japanese Buddhist Goddess) spoke about while appearing in a dream. There's also a legend that you can increase your luck with money if you wash some in the Takara Pond.



9 Atagawa Tropical & Alligator Garden
A zoo where the heat from hot springs is used to breed and culture crocodiles and tropical plants. You've also got to see the cute red pandas and the Amazon manatees.



10 Izu Animal Kingdom
There are a lot of rare animals, like white tigers. This zoo lets you interact directly with many different animals.



11 Kawazu Nanadaru Seven Waterfalls
The seven waterfalls in this spot provide a great deal of comfort. You can also enjoy a relaxing walk along the promenade. There's a bronze statue from renowned author Yasunari Kawabata's "The Dancing Girl of Izu," making this a famous spot for commemorative photos.



12 Shimoda Aquarium
An aquarium that makes the most of the natural beauty of Izu's ocean where you can play with dolphins. During the show, you may be able to have the special experience of having the dolphins jump directly over your head.



13 Izu Cruise
An open-air bath so close to the sea that you can feel the spray of the waves. A vast, open ocean view spreads out before you.



14 Shirahama Shrine
This is the oldest shrine in Izu. The bright red coastal torii gate, standing right in front of the blue sea of Shirahama, is a popular spiritual spot.



15 Ryugukutsu Cave
A portion of the ceiling of this large sea cave has given way, opening up a skylight that's around 50 meters in diameter. Looking up from below, you'll find yourself in a curious space where the ceiling suddenly opens up. There's a promenade above, and you can walk all the way around. If you look down, you'll be able to see a heart-shaped landform!



16 Yumigahama Beach
Yumigahama has a beautiful coastline that extends for over 1 km, along with broad stretches of white, sandy beaches. This beach in the southernmost part of Minamizu was selected as one of the 100 best shores in Japan.



17 Shimoda Ropeway
It's approximately 3 minutes by ropeway to the top of Mt. Nesugata, where you can have a bird's-eye view of Shimoda Port, the Izu Islands and the magnificent Amagi Mountains. At the summit, you will find Aizendo, a famous spot associated with matchmaking, among other attractions.



18 Irozaki Lighthouse
You can see the horizon from the tip of the southernmost cape of the Izu Peninsula and check to see if the earth really is round. This medium-sized lighthouse, which stands as a tower of chalk, was selected as one of the fifty most notable lighthouses in Japan.



19 Observation Cafe & Restaurant THE ROYAL HOUSE
This is a cafe located at the summit of Mt. Nesugata, accessible via the Shimoda Ropeway. Enjoy an elegant moment of your journey in a beautifully designed space adorned with traditional craftsmanship and scenic views.



20 Zushu KIYOTAYA
Inside Izu-Kōgen Station, Izu-Atagawa Station, Kawazu Station, and Izukyū-Shimoda Station; 2nd floor of Lusca Atami
