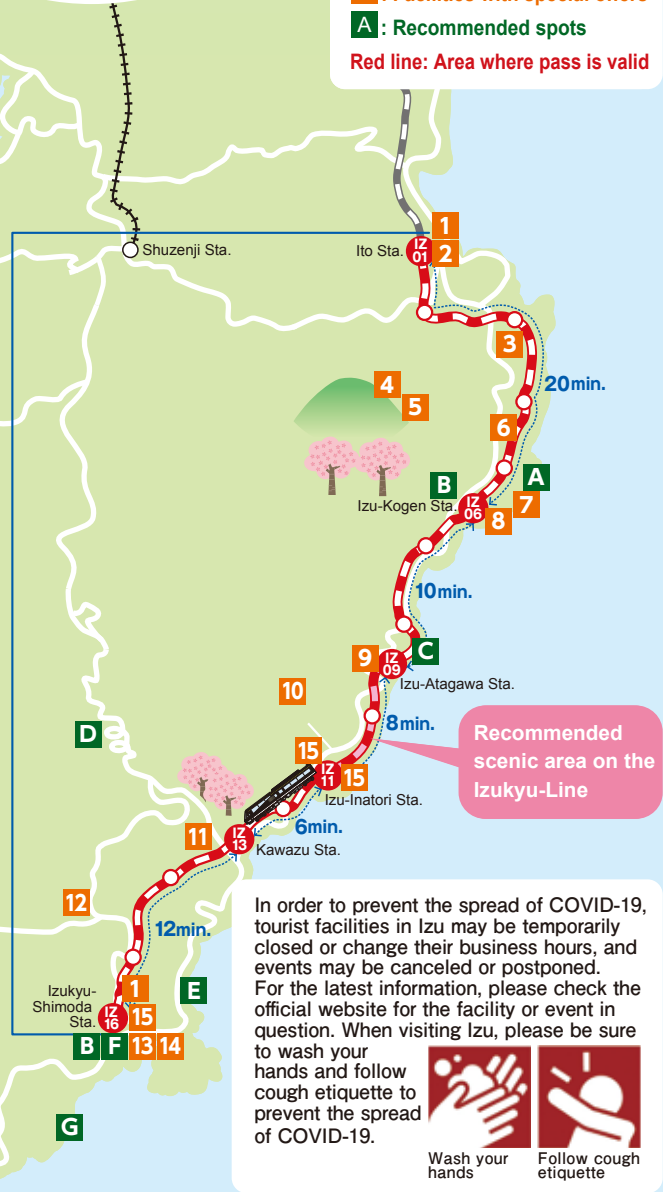




# IZU PENINSULA MAP

 Red line: Area where pass is valid



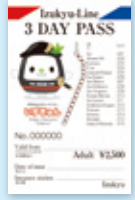

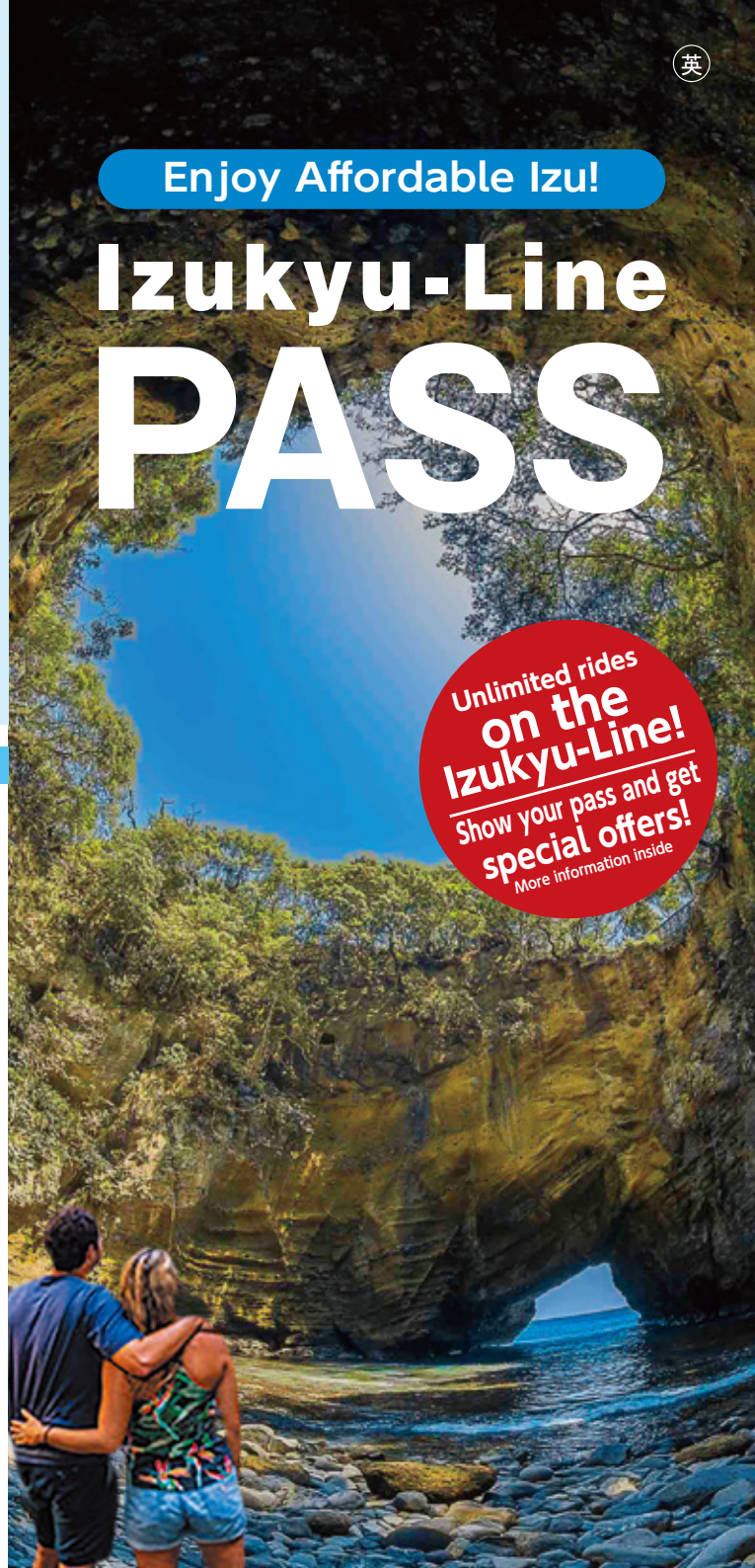


## Conditions of Use

The Izukyu-Line **1 DAY PASS**, **2 DAY PASS**, and **3 DAY PASS** is special rail pass for international visitors using the Izukyu-Line. (Ito Sta. - Izu-Shimoda Sta.)

- **Period of Validity** Izukyu-Line 1 DAY PASS: 1 day  
 Izukyu-Line 2 DAY PASS: 2 consecutive days  
 Izukyu-Line 3 DAY PASS: 3 consecutive days
- **Usage** Non-reserved seats on local trains (including rapid trains) on the Izukyu-Line
- **Purchasing** Only available for purchase upon presentation of a non-Japanese passport
- **Refunds** Generally not allowed
- **Issuing Stations** Ito Sta. (7:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m.)  
 Izu-Kogen Sta., Izu-Shimoda Sta. (6:00 a.m. - 7:00 p.m.)  
 Izu-Atagawa Sta., Izu-Inatori Sta., Kawazu Sta. (8:10 a.m. - 5:30 p.m.)
- **Other** You may be asked to provide your passport after purchase. Passes cannot be purchased at the arrival station or onboard trains. Please buy your pass in advance.

## A Jogasaki Coast / Kadowaki Suspension Bridge

- 1 Jogasaki-Kaigan Sta. (Izuky-Line)
- 2 25 minute walk from Jogasaki-Kaigan Sta.



## B Izukyu Rental Bicycle Izu Potter

- 1 Izu-Kogen Sta. / Izuky-Shimoda Sta. (Izuky-Line)
- 2 Open everyday \*unavailable on rainy days
- 3 9:00 - 16:30(Izu-Kogen) / 9:30 - 16:00(Shimoda)
- 4 1 day: 2,200 yen, 2 hours: 1,100 yen (with tax)



## C Takaiso-no-Yu

- 1 Izu-Atagawa Sta. (Izuky-Line)
- 2 15 minute walk from Izu-Atagawa Sta.
- 3 Friday - Sunday \*closed on stormy days
- 4 9:30 - 17:00
- 5 Adult(middle school students and older) 600 yen  
Child (4 years old - elementary school) 300 yen (with tax)  
\*With pool entry in the summer Adult: 700 yen, Child: 350 yen



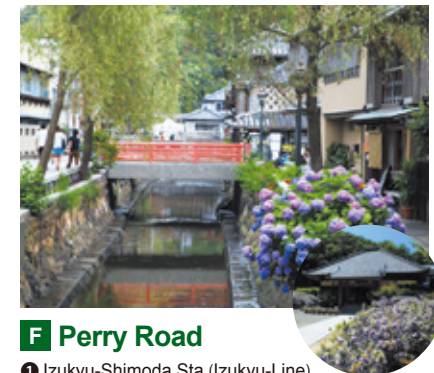
## D Kawazu Nanadaru Waterfalls

- 1 Kawazu Sta. (Izuky-Line)
- 2 25 minute bus ride from Kawazu Sta. bound for Shuzenji and 10 minute walk from Kawazu Nanadaru Bus Stop



## E Shirahama Seaside Resort / Shirahama Shrine

- 1 Izuky-Shimoda Sta.(Izuky-Line)
- 2 From Izuky-Shimoda Station bound for Shirahama Approx. a 15 minute bus ride. Short walk from Respo Shirahama bus stop.



## F Perry Road

- 1 Izuky-Shimoda Sta.(Izuky-Line)
- 2 10 minute walk from Izuky-Shimoda Sta.



## G Ryugu Sea Cave / Toji Sand Ski Ground

- 1 Izuky-Shimoda Sta.(Izuky-Line)
- 2 From Izuky-Shimoda Station bound for Toji Approx. 20 minute bus ride. Short walk from Ryugukutsu (Ryugu Sea Cave) Bus Stop.

## ★ Diving

Izu is a world famous diving area with over 30 diving points scattered throughout the region. Take in the interesting terrain produced by volcanic activity or partake in the wreck diving opportunities available in the Izu waters.
